

Comments: This community-wide election calendar proves that the Sun City Anthem Board and Election Committee and RMI Licensed Community Manager willfully and knowingly planned to deny candidates the right to mail candidate information sheets at least 30 days before the election which was planned to be 7 or 8 April 2011. Compliance with NRS116.31034.12 would have required the candidate information sheets to be distributed on or before 7 March 2011.
